## **Special Meeting Minutes**

January 6, 2020

The Ocean Highway and Port Authority of Nassau County held a Special Meeting at the John Drew Tax Collector Building, 86130 License Road, Suite 9, Fernandina Beach, Florida 32034.

The meeting was called to order at 10:01 AM by Chairman Danny Fullwood.

The invocation was given and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairman Fullwood. Roll call was conducted by Ms. Barbara Amergian. All Commissioners were present. Also in attendance was Jeb Branham, Port Attorney; and Chris Ragucci, Port Operator.
